The pupils will visit a number of scenario areas in an interactive safety centre and will receive important information about:

- Fire Safety in the Home (Tyne and Wear Fire and Rescue Service)
- Personal Choices and Consequences of Crime (Northumbria Police)
- Road Safety - keeping safe crossing roads (Sunderland Road Safety Team)
